2025 Call for Nominations



This award is sponsored by the Agricultural and Food Chemistry Division (AGFD) of the American Chemical Society (ACS). The award is designed to recognize outstanding scientific contributions to the field of agricultural and food chemistry by scientists early in their careers

The Award consists of:

- an engraved plaque to commemorate this distinguished award
- a cash award of \$1000
- an invitation to present their research at the Fall ACS National Meeting
- up to \$1,000 for travel expense reimbursement.

Nominations are open to young scientists who have earned their last degree within 12 years of October 1 of the year of presentation

Nominees are required to have been active members of the AGFD for a minimum of three years when submitting their applications.

A technically diverse board of AGFD judges will select the awardee

The award is presented during the AGFD Technical Program at the Fall ACS Meeting

Nominations/ Applications must be submitted by email and contain

- 1. Nomination letter from a member of AGFD
- 2. Two letters of recommendation
- 3. Two page summary of the research of significance
- 4. Curriculum vitae including a list of publications, patents and presentations
- 5. Abstract of the proposed oral presentation
