Sponsor: Division of Agricultural and Food Chemistry (AGFD) of the American Chemical Society (ACS)

Purpose: This research and poster competition is designed to showcase the research talents of undergraduate students, provide a professional forum for presentation of their research and promote their continuance of education in food & agricultural chemistry.

Eligibility: Participation in the competition is open to all undergraduate students actively participating in research projects/programs in the areas of food and agricultural chemistry. **Applicants must be members of ACS and AGFD.**

Venue/Date: The poster session will be held in conjunction with the AGFD General Poster session at the ACS Spring National Meeting in New Orleans, LA on March 21 – 25, 2027.

Travel Award: Those students chosen to participate as Finalists in the poster symposium will receive coverage of \$1000 of travel expenses to attend and present their research during the AGFD General poster session at the Spring meeting of the ACS.

Award Winners: The winners will receive a cash award of \$500, \$250, and \$100 for first, second, and third place, respectively.

2. Resume (maximum 1 page)
3. Letters of recommendation from one professor (<1000 words)
4. Abstract of the proposed poster presentation (also submit abstract to ACS MAPS Online system to the AGFD General Poster Session)
